Up to 14 Junior Research Fellowships are available commencing between
1 October 2011 and 1 April 2012.

The normal period of the Fellowship will be 2 years, though a case for a shorter or longer period can be made (minimum of one year and a maximum of 3 years)

Starting salary will be in the range £29,972–£33,734 p.a.
